You likely won't have time to discuss all of the questions so choose which questions you will ask ahead of time and make sure to provide plenty of time to focus on the application questions.

- You may want to share the link to these questions with everyone so they can follow along with the questions as you read them.

Colossians – Act II

**GATHERING** (*pick 1*)

- Have you ever taken a class on, read a book about, or followed a particular philosophy?
- How have you enacted rules and regulations around diet, life, health, work, spiritual disciplines?
- What do you think of when you think of roots and foundations?

**OPENING** (*pick 1 or 2*)

- As you reflect on Sunday's message, what one principle or insight stands out as being particularly helpful, insightful, or difficult to grasp?
- If that sermon had to be re-delivered, what two points or ideas do you wish were discussed no matter what?
- What's one thing from Sunday's reflections that you hope we talk about as a group?
- Was there any one thing that you most agreed with or disagreed with Sunday's message? What was it and why?
- What might you do in the next few weeks to engage your church?

**DIGGING DEEPER** (*pick 1 passage and read together*)

- Choose a Reading: Colossians 2, Romans 12:1-2, Ephesians 6:10-13
  - Reflecting on these verses, what strikes you most? Why?
  - What is most challenging in these verses? Encouraging? New?
  - If these verses were applied to our lives today, how would we move?
  - How could we more faithfully greet our church community?

**APPLYING** (*pick 1, do another as time allows*)

- If you were to incorporate this message into your own life, how would the next month be different?
- How can the message of Colossians help you discern propaganda which leads away from an "in Christ life"?
- Pray over the summer months ahead, how can you learn the treasures of wisdom and knowledge found in Christ?
- How can we pray for you regarding living the truths from today's conversation?
